The Rivalry

The second season of REPLAY the Series will reunite two high school hockey teams from the Detroit area: Trenton vs. Detroit Catholic Central (CC). The teams were unable to complete their second match up of the 1999 season when, with 10 minutes left in the third period and the score tied 4-4, a Trenton player was accidentally slashed in the jugular by the skate of a CC player. The two teams convened on the ice to pray for their fellow athlete and were unable to finish the game. The injured player made a full recovery, but his teammates were not able to recoup their composure and went on to a disappointing showing in the post-season. CC proceeded to win the Michigan state hockey championships that year with their only loss all season being their first match up with Trenton.
